Dear Rockville High School Parents/Guardians:

The RHS Freshman Intervention program is designed to be a positive experience for everyone. The extension of the school curriculum into the summer months provides students the ability to recover credit and continue on track for graduation. The freshman intervention is designed to recover credit in either Algebra 1, English 9 or Physical Education.

Please review the following information prior to enrolling your student in our program.

- Freshman Intervention program will run from Monday, June 21nd to July 22nd. The hours are from 8:30 - 12:00. The program runs Monday - Thursday. There will be no classes on Monday, July 5th in observance of the July 4th holiday.
- There is an attendance requirement. **Attendance is mandatory.** If a student is absent more than twice during the entire program he/she will be removed from the program. Every two tardies count as an absence.

**OTHER:**

- Bus transportation will be provided to and from the nearest elementary school.
- Masks will be required for students and staff.
- A bagged breakfast and lunch will be provided.
- The discipline and school dress codes for summer school are the same as those in place during the regular school year. Violation of the discipline code may result in automatic dismissal from summer school. Cell phones and electronic devices may not be used during instruction time.
