1. How do I join the Banner Yearbook Committee?

The yearbook committee starts meeting at the end of September and continues until mid March. Meetings are Mondays after school from 2-3:30 in the Library's Makerspace.

2. What are the benefits of joining the yearbook committee?

- Make new friends
- Free snacks at meetings
- Be involved in the school community
- Develop artistic/design skills
- Design and obtain yearbook shirts to help with advertising
- Have a say in your yearbook
- Earn a free yearbook senior year (advisors' discretion)

3. How do I purchase a yearbook?

Yearbooks can be purchased online by clicking [here](#). In February we have to give our final yearbook count, so buy your copy ahead of time to guarantee that you get a yearbook!

Also note: The price of yearbooks increases as the year goes on, so purchasing your yearbook early will also provide the best deal as well as secure your copy.

4. How do I schedule a senior portrait?

Please note: Portraits must be done with Prestige Lifetouch to be included in the yearbook. These portraits are different from school ID pictures taken without appointments.

5. How do I select the senior portrait pose for the yearbook?

Once you've claimed your proofs, follow the following steps obtained from the [Prestige/Lifetouch FAQ](#):

- a. Click "View Proofs".
- b. Look for the "Select your Yearbook Portrait" box.
- c. Click "Select Pose" to open the selection panel.
- d. View Yearbook acceptable images by using the slider arrows in the pop up window.
- e. Once the large preview shows the pose you want to select for your yearbook, click "Submit Portrait" at the bottom of the window.
- f. Confirm your choice by clicking "Yes, Submit Portrait."

- g. Your pose selection will be displayed on your proof page in the Yearbook Portrait box.
- h. You must select a photo with a blue background and cannot select a cap and gown or other specialty pose.
